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\* Emanuel Swedenborg, *True Christianity* 330 Note: Swedenborg wrote in Latin. The Latin word here is "uxor," meaning "wife," "the female spouse". And yet the concept that Swedenborg is talking about is one that relates to both males and females. The fact that Swedenborg used "uxor" instead of "conjux" (or "conjux"—an alternate spelling) meaning "married partner" may be explained by the fact that he typically wrote from a male perspective.

2. [Attitude toward marriage]
  - a. [Come into a settled belief that marriages are holy and praiseworthy.]<sup>70</sup>
    - 1) [Marriage is holy.]<sup>71</sup>
    - 2) [Note:] The love of marriage is...holy and heavenly because it has its beginning in the [deepest reaches] of a person from the Lord Himself, and it descends according to order to the outmost parts of the body.<sup>72</sup>
    - 3) [Note:] How holy marriages are in themselves...can be seen from the fact that they are seminaries of the human race and...also...of heaven. By marriages not only the earths but also the heavens are filled with inhabitants.<sup>73</sup>
  - b. [Uphold marriages as being holy.]<sup>74</sup>
  - c. [Come into a settled] belief that marriages and adulteries...differ in their essence.<sup>75</sup>
    - 1) [Note:] The difference between [marriages and adulteries] is like the difference between heaven and hell.<sup>76</sup>

  - 7) [Each partner acknowledge the other] as an agent recognizes its reagent, each in its turn.<sup>120</sup>
  - 8) Mutually regard each other from [married] love.<sup>121</sup>
  - 9) [Hold your married partner in high regard.]<sup>122</sup>
  - 10) [Turn toward your spouse.]
    - a) Turn [your] face to [your spouse].<sup>123</sup>
    - b) [Note:] The union of truth and good is effected in the spiritual world by looking.<sup>124</sup>
  - 11) [Be accepting of your spouse.]<sup>125</sup>
  - 12) [Work together and get along in marriage.]<sup>126</sup>
  - 13) [Be in a] life of mutual discourse and intercourse.<sup>127</sup>
  - 14) [Look to what is] mutual in the mind and body of [your spouse].<sup>128</sup>
  - 15) Love each other mutually and reciprocally...as to [your] bodies.<sup>129</sup>
  - 16) [Allow] each and all things in the body of the one look to their mutual in the body of the other.<sup>130</sup>
    - a) [Note:] This is genuine marriage.<sup>131</sup>
- d. Innocence
- 1) [Be] innocent.<sup>132</sup>
    - a) [Note:] Innocence is loving the Lord as your Father...
      - (1) By doing [the Lord's] commandments...
      - (2) And [by] wishing to be led by Him and not by yourself...
      - (3) Thus like an infant.<sup>133</sup>
    - b) [Note:] The love of marriage is represented in the spiritual world as a [beautiful] virgin.<sup>134</sup>
      - (1) [Further editorial note: Swedenborg suggests that for people whose physical virginity has been lost or given away outside the context of marriage, a state of spiritual and emotional virginity can still exist or be regained. Virginity is state of mind first, and a state of the body second.]
- e. Peace
- 1) Married love is...peace.<sup>135</sup>
  - 2) Peace...has its seat chiefly in married love.<sup>136</sup>
  - 3) All the delight of [married] love descends and derives its essence from heavenly peace.<sup>137</sup>
  - 4) Peace is...the very being of all joy between [a married] pair.<sup>138</sup>
  - 5) Peace is happiness of heart and soul arising from the union of the Lord with heaven and the church, as well as from the union of good and

- truth, when all conflict and combat of evil and falsity with good and truth has ceased.<sup>139</sup>
- 6) Peace...is inmost joy of heart from a complete safety from the hells, and [also from] a protection [against] infestations of evil and falsity therefrom.<sup>140</sup>
  - 7) This peace shines forth in the heavens as heavenly happiness from the faces of a married pair who are in [married] love.<sup>141</sup>
- f. Wisdom
- 1) A person has such and so much of intelligence and wisdom as he or she has of married love.<sup>142</sup>
    - a) [Note:] By intelligence and wisdom [is meant] the faculty of seeing and understanding truths and goods.<sup>143</sup>
- g. Chastity in marriage
- 1) [Allow] chastity [to descend into you] from above.<sup>144</sup>
  - 2) [Be] in the chaste love of marriage.<sup>145</sup>
  - 3) Live in chaste [marriage].<sup>146</sup>
  - 4) [Cherish clean] thoughts respecting such things as pertain to marriage.<sup>147</sup>
    - a) [Entertain] chaste and [clean] thoughts.<sup>148</sup>

        - (a) [Note:] From true married love there is power and protection against the hells.<sup>158</sup>
        - (b) [Note:] At the presence of married love diabolical spirits become furious, insane, and mentally impotent, and cast themselves into the deep.<sup>159</sup>
    - d) The goods of chastity...that are done by a person who shuns adulteries as sins against God...are goods [that relate to]...
      - (1) Spiritual and heavenly loves.<sup>160</sup>
      - (2) Intelligence and wisdom.<sup>161</sup>
      - (3) Innocence and peace.<sup>162</sup>

- (4) Power and protection against the hells and against the evils and the falsities therefrom.<sup>163</sup>

  - s. [Allow each to acknowledge the other] as an agent recognizes its re-agent, each in its turn.<sup>191</sup>
  - t. [Note:] This universal marriage is the source of married love between husband and wife.<sup>192</sup>
  - u. [Receive] light and heat from the Lord as a sun, that is,...
    - 1) [Receive] Divine truth conjoined to Divine good, and...Divine good conjoined to Divine truth.<sup>193</sup>
  - v. [Be in] truths and a life according to them.<sup>194</sup>
  - w. [Live] in the marriage of [good] and [truth] by...<sup>195</sup>
    - 1) Thinking [goods] and [truths] from a delight in them.
    - 2) Doing goods and truths from a love for them.
  - x. [Be in truths] as to doctrine and in [goods] as to life.<sup>196</sup>

7. [Receive your husband's soul] in [your] heart.<sup>224</sup>

1. [Note: Married] love can exist only through a marriage in which the man is truth and the wife is good.<sup>228</sup>

- a. [Note:] The husband [has been created] to be truth and the wife good, thus that both may be truth and good in form, which form is a person and the image of God.<sup>231</sup>
- 4. [Be so to speak] the soul of [your] wife.<sup>232</sup>
- 5. Love good continually.<sup>233</sup>
- 6. [Communicate] and [unite your] soul to [your] wife by actual love.<sup>234</sup>
  - a. [Notes:]
    - 1) [A husband's soul] is in his seed.<sup>235</sup>
    - 2) In man's seed there lies hidden the inmost of his life, and thus the rudiment of a new life.<sup>236</sup>
      - a) For this reason it is holy.<sup>237</sup>
    - 3) In chaste marriages...the life of the husband adds itself through the seed to the life of the wife.<sup>238</sup>
    - 4) From this there is inmost conjunction, by which they become not two, but one flesh.<sup>239</sup>
      - a) From this the two become one.<sup>240</sup>
    - 5) And according to union by means of that, married love increases, and with it every good of heaven.<sup>241</sup>
- 7. Turn [your] face to [your wife].<sup>242</sup>
  - a. [Notes:]
    - 1) The union of truth and good is effected in the spiritual world by looking.<sup>243</sup>

  - e. [Allow there to be] a union of the two minds into one.<sup>263</sup>

- 1) [Allow] two minds [to be] so united as to be one mind.<sup>264</sup>
- 2) [Note:] Married love [descends from this].<sup>265</sup>
- 3) [Note: Then] there is love between [husband and wife].<sup>266</sup>
- f. [Work toward a] marriage of two minds into one.<sup>267</sup>
- g. [Let there be a] union of minds [as well as a union of bodies].<sup>268</sup>
- h. [Be united] in internals [as well as in externals].<sup>269</sup>
- i. [Allow this] love of spiritual marriage [to descend] into the body.<sup>270</sup>
  - 1) [Note: There] it becomes the love of natural marriage.<sup>271</sup>
- j. [Note:] All love descends into the body from an affection of the mind, and...apart from such an origin no love exists.<sup>272</sup>
- k. [Work toward a] marriage of two minds and two bodies.<sup>273</sup>
- l. [Allow] each and all things in the body of the one look to their mutual in the body of the other.<sup>274</sup>
  - 1) [Note:] This is genuine marriage.<sup>275</sup>
4. [Be in mutual love and regard for one another. Note: This section is a repeat of a section above.]
  - a. Be one through mutual love from love to the Lord.<sup>276</sup>
  - b. Love each other mutually and reciprocally.<sup>277</sup>
  - c. Love one another mutually and reciprocally from the heart, thus from [your deepest self].<sup>278</sup>
    - 1) [Note:] The love of marriage...has its beginning in the [deepest reaches] of a person from the Lord Himself, and it descends according to order to the outmost parts of the body.<sup>279</sup>
  - d. [Love each other interiorly, that is, as to your minds.]<sup>280</sup>
    - 1) [Note: This is the way to] love each other mutually and reciprocally.<sup>281</sup>
  - e. [Acknowledge one another mutually and reciprocally.]<sup>282</sup>
  - f. [Each partner acknowledge] the other as [his or her] mutual and reciprocal.<sup>283</sup>
  - g. [Each partner acknowledge the other] as an agent recognizes its re-agent, each in its turn.<sup>284</sup>
  - h. Mutually regard each other from [married] love.<sup>285</sup>
  - i. [Hold your married partner in high regard.]<sup>286</sup>
  - j. [Turn toward your spouse.]
    - 1) Turn [your] face to [your spouse].<sup>287</sup>
    - 2) [Note:] The union of truth and good is effected in the spiritual world by looking.<sup>288</sup>
  - k. [Be accepting of your spouse.]<sup>289</sup>
  - l. [Work together and get along in marriage.]<sup>290</sup>
  - m. [Be in a] life of mutual discourse and intercourse.<sup>291</sup>
  - n. [Look to what is] mutual in the mind and body of [your spouse].<sup>292</sup>
  - o. Love each other mutually and reciprocally...as to [your] bodies.<sup>293</sup>
  - p. [Allow] each and all things in the body of the one look to their mutual in the body of the other.<sup>294</sup>
    - 1) [Note:] This is genuine marriage.<sup>295</sup>
5. [Function together as one.]
  - a. Be one through mutual love from love to the Lord.<sup>296</sup>
  - b. [Allow your] two minds [to] act as one.<sup>297</sup>
  - c. Although [you are] apparently two...actually [be] one.<sup>298</sup>
  - d. [Be] one.<sup>299</sup>
  - e. Have one life.<sup>300</sup>

- f. [Be] like the life of good in truth and the life of truth in good.<sup>301</sup>
- g. [Be] two as to [your] bodies, but one as to life.<sup>302</sup>
- h. [Be] one in regard to life and the activities of life, which are useful services.<sup>303</sup>
- i. [Be] like the [pairs of organs or members in the human body].<sup>304</sup>
  - 1) [Be like two] eyes--[be] one as to...sight.<sup>305</sup>
  - 2) [Be like two] ears--[be] one as to hearing.<sup>306</sup>
  - 3) [Be like two] arms--[be] one as to action.<sup>307</sup>
  - 4) [Be like two] feet--[be] one as to walking.<sup>308</sup>
  - 5) [Be like two] arms and [two] feet--[be] one as to useful service.<sup>309</sup>
- j. [Although you are] two partners (and in heaven, two angels) [be as though] one.<sup>310</sup>
- k. [Notes:]
  - 1) All these [pairs (and other similar pairs in the body)] have reference to good and truth, the organ or member on the right to good, and that on the left to truth.<sup>311</sup>
  - 2) It is the same with a husband and wife, between whom there is true married love; they are two as to their bodies but one as to life.<sup>312</sup>
  - 3) Consequently in heaven two partners are not called two angels but one.<sup>313</sup>
- 6. [Have joy and delight.]
  - a. [Welcome] new [forms of delight].<sup>314</sup>
  - b. [Allow] playfulness [to be in your marriage].<sup>315</sup>
  - c. [Put] on the liveliness, gladness, and freshness of youth.<sup>316</sup>
  - d. [Entertain] joy [in your marriage].<sup>317</sup>
  - e. [Have a] life of joy [together].<sup>318</sup>

**[Forms of good that relate to the bearing of offspring:]**

- 1. [Allow] procreations [to be] effected by marriages in which true married love [reigns].<sup>319</sup>

**[The origin of married love:]**

- 1. [The origin of married love is the Lord's love for people.]
  - a. The origin of true married love is the Lord's love for the church.<sup>320</sup>
  - b. Married love is derived from the Lord's love for the church.<sup>321</sup>
- 2. [The origin of married love is the Lord's union with individuals.]
  - a. The...origin of true married love with a person of the church is the Lord's union with that person.<sup>322</sup>
    - 1) [Note:] It is from this marriage that the church is the church in general and in particular.<sup>323</sup>
- 3. [The origin of married love is the marriage of goodness and truth.]
  - a. The origin of married love is the marriage of good and truth.<sup>324</sup>
  - b. Married love is derived from the love of good and truth.<sup>325</sup>
  - c. Married love...descends from the love of good and truth, which is spiritual.<sup>326</sup>
  - d. Married love...descends [from the love of good and truth] as the [very] love of the heavens.<sup>327</sup>
  - e. [Married love] is from the marriage of good and truth.<sup>328</sup>
  - f. From [the doctrine of truth united to good] a desire and favor for [marriage] flow in from heaven.<sup>329</sup>

- g. The union of [good and truth] is spiritual [marriage] from which, according to correspondence, natural [marriage] exists.<sup>330</sup>
- h. The love of a married pair corresponds to the love of good and truth.<sup>331</sup>

**[Information about married love:]**

1. [Married love is from the Lord alone.]
  - a. True married love is from the Lord alone.<sup>332</sup>
  - b. True married love in its first essence is love to the Lord from the Lord.<sup>333</sup>
2. [Married love is an image of the Lord.]
  - a. True married love is an image of the Lord.<sup>334</sup>
3. [Married love is an image like an angel.]
  - a. In the spiritual world married love appears in form like an angel.<sup>335</sup>
4. [Married love is an image of heaven.]
  - a. Marriage is heaven with a person.<sup>336</sup>
  - b. The delight of marriage is heaven with a person.<sup>337</sup>
  - c. Marriage is an image of heaven.<sup>338</sup>
    - 1) [Note:] Heaven is a marriage.<sup>339</sup>
5. [Married love is the foundational form of love.]
  - a. The chaste love of marriage is the foundational love of all heavenly and Divine loves.<sup>340</sup>
  - b. Married love is the foundational love of all the loves of heaven.<sup>341</sup>
  - c. Married love is the foundational love of all [heavenly] and spiritual loves.<sup>342</sup>
  - d. It is also the foundational of all the delights and joys of heaven, since every delight and joy is of love.<sup>343</sup>
  - e. [Therefore] heavenly joys...have their origins and their causes from married love.<sup>344</sup>
  - f. The love of marriage...is full of countless delights.<sup>345</sup>
    - 1) [Note: They] cannot be numbered or described.<sup>346</sup>
    - 2) [Note:] What's more, they are multiplied with continual increase to eternity.<sup>347</sup>
6. [Married love is related to true religion and to spirituality.]
  - a. The chastity of marriage makes one with religion.<sup>348</sup>
  - b. The [purity] of marriage makes one with [spirituality].<sup>349</sup>
7. [Married love is innocence.]
  - a. [Married love] is...innocence.<sup>350</sup>
    - 1) [Note:] Innocence is loving the Lord as your Father by doing [the Lord's] commandments and wishing to be led by Him and not by yourself, thus like an infant.<sup>351</sup>
8. [Married love is peace. Note: This section is a repeat of a section above.]
  - a. Married love is...peace.<sup>352</sup>
  - b. Peace...has its seat chiefly in married love.<sup>353</sup>
  - c. All the delight of [married] love descends and derives its essence from heavenly peace.<sup>354</sup>
  - d. Peace is...the very being of all joy between [a married] pair. AE 997:4
  - e. Peace is happiness of heart and soul arising from the union of the Lord with heaven and the church, as well as from the union of good and truth, when all conflict and combat of evil and falsity with good and truth has ceased.<sup>355</sup>

- f. Peace...is inmost joy of heart from a complete safety from the hells, and [also from] a protection [against] infestations of evil and falsity therefrom.<sup>356</sup>
- g. This peace shines forth in the heavens as heavenly happiness from the faces of a married pair who are in [married] love.<sup>357</sup>

**[Relationship of married love to the Lord's Word:]**

- 1. [Married] love and the organs [of generation] correspond to the Word.<sup>358</sup>
  - a. The reason is that the Word is the Divine truth united to the Divine good proceeding from the Lord.<sup>359</sup>
- 2. In every particular of the Word there is a marriage of good and truth.<sup>360</sup>
  - a. [Note: It is the] heavenly marriage.<sup>361</sup>
    - 1) From this...it is clear how holy and heavenly marriages are in themselves.<sup>362</sup>
- 3. [Therefore...]
  - a. [Make an] account of Divine truths.<sup>363</sup>
  - b. [Make an] account of the Word.<sup>364</sup>
  - c. [Uphold] the holy things that are in the Word...from the heart.<sup>365</sup>
  - d. Believe that sins are remitted by...repentance of life.<sup>366</sup>
  - e. [Study] the Word...for the sake of spiritual useful services.<sup>367</sup>

**[Results of married love when it is present in a person:]**

- 1. Through married love a person has union with the Lord.<sup>368</sup>
- 2. From [married love] a person has heaven.<sup>369</sup>
  - a. A person has so much of heaven in him- or herself, or he is so much in heaven, as he is in married love, because he is so far in innocence.<sup>370</sup>
- 3. Through married love a person has heaven and the church.<sup>371</sup>
- 4. [Marriages] close [hell] and open [heaven].<sup>372</sup>
  - a. From true married love there is power and protection against the hells.<sup>373</sup>
- 5. From...marriages in which there is true married love all delights and felicities increase even to the delights and felicities of the inmost heaven.<sup>374</sup>
- 6. Through [married] love a person becomes love.<sup>375</sup>
- 7. From [married love] each of the marriage pair loves the other as good loves truth and truth loves good.<sup>376</sup>
- 8. A person has such and so much of intelligence and wisdom as he or she has of married love.<sup>377</sup>
  - a. [Note:] By intelligence and wisdom [is meant] the faculty of seeing and understanding truths and goods.<sup>378</sup>
- 9. Through married love a person has peace.<sup>379</sup>
- 10. True married love is innocence, [and because of that] the playfulness between a married pair is like the play of infants together; and this is so in the measure in which they love each other.<sup>380</sup>
- 11. There is nothing of lasciviousness and thus nothing of shame between a married pair, any more than between little children when they are naked together.<sup>381</sup>
- 12. In the heavens the angels are beautiful according to the quality of married love with them.<sup>382</sup>
- 13. Angels have all their beauty from married love; thus each angel has beauty in the measure of that love.<sup>383</sup>

14. The angels of heaven have life in their faces, in the movements of their body, and in their speech according to their married love.<sup>384</sup>
15. Angels in heaven...are in continual potency.<sup>385</sup>
16. [With angels] effects are constantly open.<sup>386</sup>
  - a. Effects are never lacking when angels have desire.<sup>387</sup>
  - b. Without these their love would be like the channel of a fountain stopped up.<sup>388</sup>
  - c. The effect opens that channel and causes continuance and conjunction that they may become as one flesh.<sup>389</sup>
  - d. The delights of the effects cannot be described in the expressions of any language in the natural world.<sup>390</sup>
17. [With angels] there is never any weariness after the acts, still less any sadness, but eagerness of life and cheerfulness of mind.<sup>391</sup>
18. The married pair pass the night in each other's bosoms as if they were created into one.<sup>392</sup>
19. The [vitality] of the husband adds itself to the [vitality] of the wife and binds [them] together.<sup>393</sup>
