## Meeting notes:

2. This outline is an example of a one-hour meeting that starts at 7:00 PM. Groups that want more time for Group Sharing can lengthen that part of the meeting and adjust the meeting's end time accordingly.

7:00 p.m. Open the meeting

1. Opening prayer
2. Check-in
a. One highlight from each person's day or week, or one opening comment.
b. No cross talk or conversation during this part of the meeting.
c. Acknowledge each person's contribution with the words, "Thank you," before moving on to the next person.
d. Groups larger than eight are broken into groups of four to eight.
3. Group business
a. Any announcements or group decisions that need to be made.

7:15 Group sharing (three meeting types)

1. Step meeting
a. Focus: One of the four major steps, or else a sub-step within the process.
b. "What is your experience of living this step of the process?"
2. Topic meeting
a. Focus: A topic of someone's choosing.
3. Process meeting
a. Focus: People's recent experience of the entire BNL process.
b. "What was your experience of going through the entire BNL process?"

## 7:45 Leading Edge or Personal Time

1. One "leading edge" experience of the process, or a recent insight based on the process.
2. Alternatively, one person requests time to share a personal struggle and seek the group's support.

## 7:55 Closure

1. Leader for the next meeting
a. If the group has multiple leaders, decide who will lead the next meeting.
2. Choose a person to decide on the next meeting's Step or Topic.
a. Decided on a volunteer, rotational, or assigned basis.
3. Closing comments
a. One closing comment per person.
b. No cross talk or conversation during this part of the meeting.
c. Acknowledge each person's contribution with the words, "Thank you," before moving on to the next person.
d. Groups larger than eight are broken into groups of four to eight.
4. The Lord's Prayer
